# National Pool Lifeguard Qualification (NPLQ) Course Information

# **Course Dates:**

Our NPLQ courses normally run from Monday through to Friday (5 days), with the external examination being held on the Friday evening.

## **Course Times:**

Course times will normally be 9.00am - 6.15pm each day, Monday to Friday, (this will include 75 minutes break each day), with the exam starting at 5.00pm on the Friday evening and lasting approximately 2½ hours – 3hours.

# **Attendance Requirements:**

100% attendance for the course is required for candidates.

#### **Course Content:**

There are three basic elements:

- 1. The lifeguard and the law
- 2. The swimming pool, hazards and control measures
- 3. Swimming pool supervision

The course comprises of physical training and theoretical classroom work. You will be trained to carry out CPR, first-aid practices and given sufficient training to competently manage a range of poolside emergencies.

Throughout the course you will be continuously assessed by the trainer. The final exam will be a practical and theoretical examination to test your understanding & competency, carried out by an external examiner at the end of the course.

# **Pre-requisites:**

Before joining the course you will need to be able to complete the following:

- Jump or dive into the pool in deep water
- Swim 50 metres in 1 minute or less
- Swim 100 metres continuously on your front and then on your back
- Tread water for a minimum of 30 seconds in deep water
- Dive down to the deepest point of the pool (Poolside Manor 1.93m)
- Climb out of the pool with out the aid of steps or a ladder

# **Cost of the Course:**

The cost of the course is £249.00 (research has shown this to be an average fee for this type of course, and in some cases considerably cheaper). This covers the course materials, tuition and examination fees.

This can be booked with a non-refundable deposit of £100 at the time of booking and the remainder to be paid no later than 14 days before the start of the course. Payment can be made either in person at Poolside Manor or over the phone using a credit/debit card.
